Last year, the Hawaii Foodbank distributed over 13.7 million pounds of food from warehouse locations in Oahu and Kauai. Of the total amount distributed, over a quarter consisted of fresh produce. They also shipped 95,034 pounds of food to Maui Food Bank.
