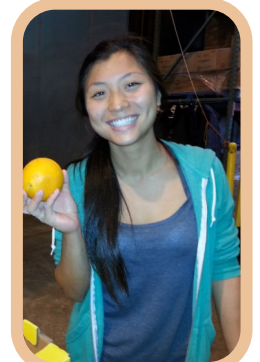

Volunteers provide an invaluable service making fruits, vegetables and other perishable foods available for Hawaii's hungry. **YOU** inspect, clean, sort and box produce and perishable items for distribution to our member agencies in the community.

Salvage/Donation Sorting

February

March

September

Special Projects
