- Receive, inventory, inspect, sort and store perishable and non-perishable foods

- Distribute an average of 946,685 pounds of food each month

- Operate according to national standards set by Feeding America, the National Food Bank Network.

- Inspect and deliver 2.3 million pounds of fresh produce annually through the Ohana Produce Plus Program to agencies across Oahu for community distribution

**Most Needed: Monetary donations, canned meats or tuna, canned meals, canned soups, canned vegetables and fruits**

Distributes over 11 million pounds of food including 2.6 million pounds of fresh produce annually or nearly 9 million meals.
